

Kev's Guide to - Ants

They may be small, but don't be fooled, invasive ants are some of the world's worst pests. These invasive ants can have a huge impact on our environment, economy, and way of life. Hundreds of millions of dollars are being spent in Australia on ant eradications and control because of their potential for devastating harm to wildlife, infrastructure, industry, and even human health. They are the gift that keeps on giving in terms of negative impact to WA now, and for future generations.

Three highly invasive ant species - the red imported fire ant, browsing ant, and African black sugar ant are all trying to gain a foothold into Western Australia. Luckily a crack team of highly trained ant surveillance officers from the WA Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development are on the case.

Have you ever wondered why your lawn gets brown patches or even dies? One of the reasons and most common is ant below the surface creating colony's, to build these underground cities they need to stabilize the ground from falling in. This is done by using a wax like substance overhead which in turns prevents grass and other plants from being able to absorb water and they start to die.

An ant treatment consists of spraying your whole block road edge to back fence, either with a repellent or non-repellent chemical depending on the environment. We also have baiting options or granulated products depending on the conditions on your block which we are happy to discuss when booking and on the day of treatment.

We also do an internal cracks and crevice treatment which will block the ants under your home from coming inside. This is a complete ant treatment with the bonus of it working for most ground dwelling bugs and comes with our unique 6 month warranty.
