

## Kev's Guide to - Rodent Baiting

Rodents are mammals which are characterised by a single pair of continuously growing incisors in each of the upper and lower jaws. Around the world, rats and mice are known to spread over 35 diseases. Diseases can also be transferred indirectly by ticks, fleas, and mites that live on infected rats. Rats can be discouraged and controlled simply by denying them food and shelter. Kev fix to rodents starts with an inspection of the property to identify where there living, feeding, and breeding. Then placing hard case durable locked stations baited with a mix of baits in these areas. The reason we use lockable stations is to contain the bait, rats will drag a food source to feed their young. This bait can end up outside on the lawn, placing children, pets and other off target species in danger of consuming the bait. The lockable bait stations contain the bait and prevent this from happening. The baits used are dependent on the time of year and conditions on the property, ie fruit trees, chicken, gardens, and trees because all these conditions tells me what they're eating and in turn what baits to use.
